

**Milwaukee Children's Choir has joined other Milwaukee performing arts organizations in requiring proof of vaccination or negative Covid test within 72 hours of performance for all audience members ages 12 and up. In addition, MCC will require audiences to be masked at all times while attending concerts, regardless of vaccination status.**

MCC's health and safety protocols follow local government, CDC and State of Wisconsin guidelines. Our goal is to keep patrons, staff, choristers and the community safe, and present live music as safely as possible.

Guidelines are evolving frequently, and protocols may change. Please check our website for updates.

### **Proof of Vaccination or Negative COVID-19 Test**

Concert attendees must be fully vaccinated, meaning the performance date must be at least 14 days after the second dose of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine or at least 14 days after a single-dose COVID-19 vaccine, or provide proof of a negative test result.

- **Proof of vaccination includes:** physical vaccination card, copy of vaccination card, or photo of vaccination card visibly showing the entire front of the card with date(s) of vaccination and individual's name that matches the patron's ID.
- **Proof of negative test includes:** printed negative test result or a digital negative test result that matches the patron's ID. Tests must be from no more than 72 hours prior to the performance and issued by a medical provider or pharmacy.
