

MCC Updated Health and Safety Policy July 2022

The safety and well-being of MCC choristers, families, volunteers and staff is our top priority. As of July 2022, the BA.5 subvariant of the Covid 19 virus has caused a significant uptick in positive cases. BA.5's ability to evade immunity is a large factor in the rising transmission seen in Milwaukee and elsewhere in July. MCC will continue to monitor case levels. To begin the 2022-23 Season, MCC will take the following safety precautions:

- **Face coverings** will be required for all choristers, staff and volunteers during in-person rehearsals at MYAC.
- MCC will require that all adult staff and volunteers who come in contact with our choristers show **proof of vaccination**.
- ***We also strongly encourage ALL choristers and family members currently eligible to receive the vaccine to do so.***

We will continue to monitor the local and national health guidelines as well as case levels in Milwaukee County, and will review our mask policy as the season progresses.. All policies are subject to change based on evolving guidance from the CDC, City of Milwaukee and the State of Wisconsin.
